A Look At Independent Adoption

This is an adoption where birth parents and adoptive parents meet apart from an agency and decide to make a plan with each other

How this connection is made differs with each placement. Often a mutual acquaintance puts a birth parent wishing an Independent Adoption in touch with an adoptive family. This person may be anyone, such as a physician, neighbor, school friend, co-worker, lawyer or pastor. A birth parent may not place a child for adoption for money, promises of future help, or gifts.

The State of Wisconsin allows a child to be placed in an adoptive parent's home directly from the hospital. In order for this to happen, the parents need to have a home study completed by a licensed child-placing agency. The home study should be done before the child is born.
